



Bunny Ears

What you need:

- 2x pieces of cardboard
- 2x Cotton Wool balls
- Glue
- Tape



To make:

- Fold a piece of cardboard in half (the size to fit a child's hand)
- Place child's hand on the cardboard with their fingers together and the base of their hand at the fold
- Assist child (if needed) to trace around their hand
- Cut out the hand shape then unfold the cardboard and cut at the fold to make 2 hand shapes
- Cut a strip of cardboard and tape bunny ears on one side
- Glue a pulled cotton ball to each handprint
- Tape ends of the cardboard strip together to fit child's head.

Easter Egg Keeper

What you need:

- 1x Recycled Strawberry Container
- 1x piece of cardboard
- Coloured paper cut into strips
- Glue
- Stickers



To make:

- Write child's name on a piece of cardboard and glue to the top of the Strawberry container
- Decorate with Easter stickers
- Place strips of coloured paper inside ready to keep Easter Eggs safe
