



Craft Activity

Theme: Farm Animals - Cow

Intro: Cows live on Dairy Farms, they produce milk that we can drink, and they can live for up to 25 years..

Craft activity: Paper Plate Cow Face

Children will need: Paper Plate, black paper, pink paper, black texta, scissors and glue.

Instructions:

Cut various sizes of shapes from black and pink paper, these can include hearts. Cut out ear shapes and mouth shapes. Glue on and add eyes and mouth.



Extension ideas: Visit a dairy to see cows being milked. Drink some milk for morning tea. Find out what type of cows there are?

Fact: Cows show emotions (happy, sad, angry) and are known to produce more milk if they are happy and treated well



Learning Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world.

Coordinator extension ideas and group time guide

Sensory activity: Milk Experiment

You will need: Full fat milk, food colouring, dish washing liquid (a small amount in a separate dish), cotton buds, small shallow dish to pour the milk into.

Instructions: Pour some milk into the shallow dish just to cover the bottom. Drop different colours of food colouring into the milk. Optional you can add some glitter to the milk also. Place the cotton bud into the dish washing liquid, making sure that the tip is coated in the liquid. Gently touch the surface of the milk with the tip of the cotton bud and watch the chemical reaction. Every time you touch the milk with the tip of the cotton bud, you will see a different result.



